## King Protea Pin

The Protea Pin was inspired by the stylized interpretation of South Africa＇s National Flower， the King Protea，which appears on South Africa＇s Coat of Arms．The flower has many stiff，pointed petals which form a cup around the outer rim． Inside the cup is a mass of white stamen which all bend toward the center．Often the flower is pink but the petal color may sometimes gradate from cream or light yellow at the bottom to bright pink or velvet red at the top．

## Supplies：

Delica beads， 4 grams pink， 2 grams gold
Nymo D thread to match beads
Pinback， 1 1／4＂
With brick stitch，make three petals as shown in Fig．6，beginning with the widest single－bead row
