Make a comfortable necklace you'll wear again and again. It's simple and versatile. Ideas of lots of ways to use beads with this necklace will fly in class! A double-cord forms the base and is adorned with daggers which form spikey sea urchins or flowers.

Supplies: 1 yd + 6" black cord; 4" black ribbon 5/8" wide; Nymo D Thread ; 150 Dagger beads; 1 button 5/8"; 7 round pearls 6-8 mm; foam core board 8" x 10" and 6" x 6"; white glue, straight pins, needle, scissors and cutting blade.
