Learn to make basic Pointed Oval Links for a necklace or bracelet and to connect them and add a toggle closure, then go on to make a Celtic Trefoil Pin/Pendant.

Note: Students **must** know even-count circular peyote which includes a step-up at the end of each row.

Supplies:

Cylinder beads*:

Trefoil: Main Color 5 gr; Accent Color: 3 gr; second accent color 2 gr

Oval Links: Supplies for a bracelet length (multiply by 3 for a necklace): Main Color 15 gr; Accent Color: 10 gr; second accent color 5 gr

Optional Edge Beads: Size 8 Czech drops

Nymo D thread to match the main colors of beads

Synthetic wax

Size 10 beading

needles
